We are delighted to reach out with information about our celebration of Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur 5786, which will commence in the secular calendar on the 22nd of September, 2025. This year, our theme for the High Holy Days is "At One: Reckoning Within, Reconnecting Beyond." As we continue to face these immensely difficult times, the challenges and opportunities of the Days of Awe are more important than ever. This is the season to take stock of how we can do better – for ourselves, for our loved ones, for West End Synagogue, and for our whole community.

As in past years, to accommodate all, we will hold services at a larger location on the Upper West Side on Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. Please read on for important information about how you can join us.

Services: Services this year will be multi-access (in person, and on Zoom) for members in good standing and for guests who have purchased tickets.
