Job Description: Elementary and/or Middle School age Hebrew and Judaics Teacher

- Tuesdays, 4 6 PM
- Periodic Shabbat Services, family learning programs, Holiday programs/celebrations. (compensated)
- Plan innovative, stimulating classroom activities that actively engage students in the learning process. Class time is divided between Judaics curriculum (Jewish texts) and Hebrew, studied hevruta style
- On a rotating basis, every third week, plan an Opening Assembly that serves as a set induction for the planned curriculum
- Submit monthly overview and weekly lesson plans
- Attend monthly teacher meetings and learning opportunities (Compensated)
- Become familiar with Reconstructionist Judaism, its philosophy, its theology and its liturgy to deliver lessons within the framework of the movement.

Qualifications:

- Committed to teaching a liberal approach to Judaism, using progressive methods in the classroom and in Shabbat/Holiday programming
- Hebrew teaching experience (classroom, youth group or camp)
- Experience teaching a range of ages
- Strong Judaic knowledge
